Since 1680, the Sparr Family has been writing the story of Alsace wines. Passionate wine growers, generation after generation has perpetuated the passion for working the land and creating wine. Charles Sparr is the 10th generation in this long tradition. The wines of Charles Sparr give voice to the grape variety, the soils and the vintage they are grown. The vineyard variously expresses itself each year, according to its location, its microclimate and the care of the wine grower, in order to give birth to each new vintage. Charles Sparr III set up the new operations centre in Riquewihr, in order to develop, along with his father, which in 2008 saw the first vintage released. In the heart of the Alsace Vineyards, the focus is on representing the emblematic soils of the family's wine production.

It has become known for consistently producing excellent champagne and honouring its history and the culture of Champagne.

In the Middle Ages, the fame of *Le Domaine du Sancy* was so great that the local landlord reserved for his own table a part of the production to be paid as a tax by the ancestors of Monsieur François Rivière, the current proprietor and winemaker. The name of this tax was "cens" which later became "cency" and today "censy". *Le Domaine du Sancy* is a property of 16 Ha. located on the top of sunny hillsides in the superior *Muscadet de Sèvre et Maine* district, just between the Sèvre and the Maine rivers in the village of Maison sur Sèvre.

The Montresor family has its roots in France. The count Claude de Montresor had a prominent important historical position during Cardinal Richelieu days and he took part to the political events as prime counselor of Duke d'Orleans, the cousin of the king. He supported a moderate and less conservative monarchy. In the XVI century a branch of the family moved from Château Montresor, in the Loire valley to Italy and more precisely in Verona where they acquired lands and estates. When Giacomo Montresor, in the second half of the 19th century, started to sell the wines he produced under his family name, he could not imagine that one century later his wines would have reached the four cardinal points of the world. Today his successors carry on this tradition, which associates the agricultural activity to selecting, ageing, bottling and distributing operations. Montresor manages its vineyards only by natural means without the use of chemical pesticides or herbicides.
